From hypersonic technology to Advanced Air Mobility, Ohio is helping the US. military innovate.


Agility Prime


Agility Prime is a non-traditional program seeking to accelerate the commercial market for Advanced Air Mobility vehicles. Ohio is a leader in autonomous mobility and is uniquely positioned to support the Agility Prime mission because of its smart mobility infrastructure, proximity to Agility Prime leadership, Air Force testing capabilities, airworthiness expertise at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, as well as leading-edge research expertise across the state. The Springfield-Beckley Municipal Airport is home to the Ohio Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Center and SkyVision, a UAS technology that can fly beyond-visual-line-of-sight (BVLOS). The Federal Aviation Administration granted AFRL a certificate of authorization to fly and test BVLOS technology. Ohio's UAS and BVLOS efforts are award-winning and currently serving Agility Prime.




Ohio is a Department of Defense "Defense Manufacturing Community"

Ohio's Military and Federal Sector Spans the State

Ohio has military and federal installations and companies that support a variety of national defense and space missions. This includes missions from all branches of the Department of Defense (DOD) – Navy, Air Force, Army, and Coast Guard – as well as the DOD's Fourth Estate Functions, including the Defense Logistics Agency, Defense Finance Accounting Service, and Defense Supply Center Columbus. Additionally, Ohio enjoys a significant presence of NASA and Department of Homeland Security functions and a vast number of veterans through extensive Department of Veterans Affairs centers. Combined, these departments account for 82.58% of all federal jobs in Ohio.
